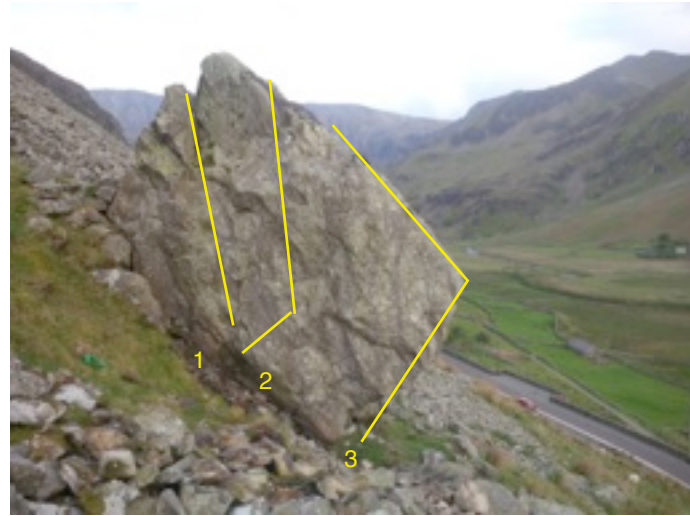
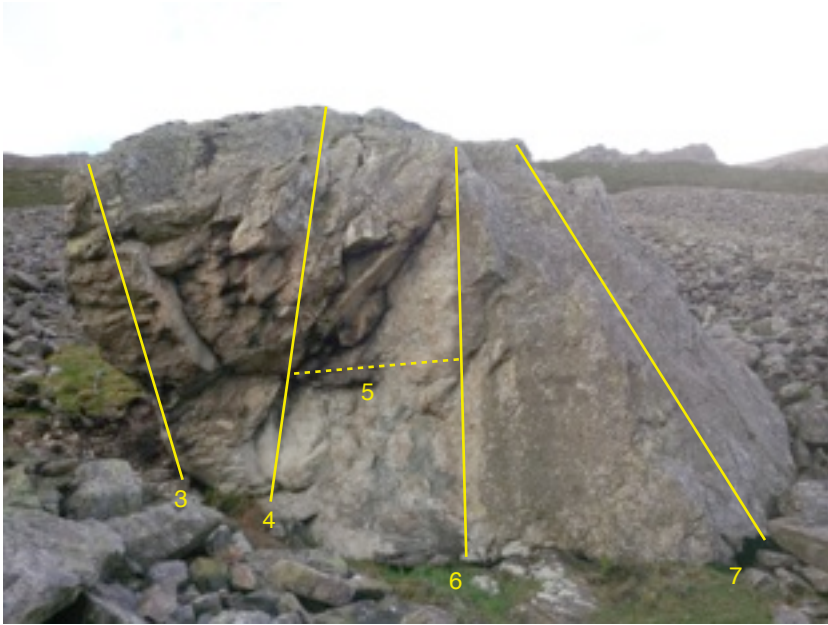


## Burley Boulder



Access: Park as for Sheep Pen: Burley boulder lies just above the small quarry beside the big layby on the left of the road as you drive up from Bethesda. Cross the wall/fence (taking care to avoid damage) by a drainage culvert at the far end of the layby and head up then left carefully to find the block. Refreshingly roadside compared with Sheep Pen. Taller climbers may find it a bit small but if you're average height or smaller it's great!

- 1) **Smith and Western 5B\*** Sit start and climb the wall via juggy ledges. [Phil Targett 2011]
- 2) **Glock 5C\*** Sit start as for Smith and Western but move right then up past a nice sloper. [Phil Targett 2011]
- 3) **Smallville 6B\*\*** Sit start under the steep prow and clamp up to victory. [Phil Targett 2011]
- 4) **Grapes of Rory McGrath 6B+\*\*** The central line through the steepness from a sit start is brilliant. [Phil Targett 2011]
- 5) **Chicken vs. Dog 6C\*** From GoRMcG sit traverse right to finish up Shaun the Sheep. [Jon Ratcliffe, 6.15]
- 6) **Shaun the Sheep 6B\*** The line of layaways leading up to the rib is good. Avoid stepping right onto easy ground above half height for the full tick. [Finn Hayward, 6.15]
- 7) **Gnat in a Hat 3\*** The slab gives pleasant padding. [Phil Targett 2011]
